To see the eclipse, <u>NASA</u> recommends exercising various safety precautions during the partial eclipse phases before and after totality, including using eclipse glasses, a handheld solar viewer, or a special-purpose solar filter over camera lenses, binoculars, and telescopes. They also recommend several

indirect viewing methods, such as a pinhole projector, which can be made right at home.

"This is a day you want to celebrate with the whole family. They will remember it for years to come," adds Cascella.

WonderWorks features over 100 hands-on, STEAM-focused exhibits, an indoor, 70foot-tall, suspended ropes course, laser tag, a 4D XD motion theater, the Wonder Zones, and more.
